Installing “WPSalesToolBox”.

Installing the plugin is like installing any other WP plugin.


Step 1: Go to the "Plugins" section and click.

Step 2: Click "Add New" and Upload the included zip file.

Step 3: Activate "WPSalesToolBox".

Using “WPSalesToolBox”.

After activating the plugin, you can start creating sales pages by going to the WPSalesToolBox Menu (Admin Sidebar) ---> Add New.




First, set some page settings (Page Title, SEO, Background Color/Image).

After setting these options, you'll be able to use enter the content of your sales page below ("Your Sales Page" field).


You'll see the "WPSalesToolBox" icon from where you can add different elements to your sales page.



Your current version may include more more elements.


Just click an element of your choice and a window with more options will Popup.

For Example, here you can see the "Action Buttons" window...



The process it's simple: You just select a image option from the drop-down (add to cart, buy now etc), a style (some elements are available in 2 styles) and when you're ready click "OK".


This will insert a shortcode inside your sales page (you can see an example below)...



... and you can see the final output (what the user will see), after publishing your page (publish and view).

Adding different elements (headlines, buttons etc) it's really easy.

An element that it's slightly different from the rest is the “Insert YouTube Video”.



Here, the most important part is to enter the video id of a youtube video.

Locating the video id of a youtube video is very easy: Just open a video and in the address bar of your browser, you'll be able to see the id after The “?” symbol. Example:



Just copy and paste that id it into the “YouTube Video ID” field.

You can add as many elements (shortcodes) and content (text / images etc) as you want.

Once you're ready, click "Publish" and you're page will be ready without all the disturbing wordpress elements (menu, sidebar and so on).
